SIIA Announces Finalists for 2011 CODiE Awards in Digital Content Categories

Winners to be announced at 2011 Information Industry Summit in New York, January 25-26

WASHINGTON, D.C. (Jan. 14, 2011) – The Software and Information Industry Association (SIIA) announces the finalists for the prestigious CODiE Awards in the categories relating to digital content aggregation, distribution, management and publishing. The products that qualified will now be reviewed by members of SIIA, who will vote on winners in six categories. The winners will be announced at a special CODiE Awards Dinner on January 25th, which will be held in conjunction with the [2011 Information Industry Summit](#) in New York City.
